Tammy read 8 books this summer. Her goal is to read 12 books before school starts. How many more books does Casey have to read to meet her goal?.

Tammy needs to read 4 more books to reach ber goal.


Tammy read 8 books. Sandy read 12 books. How many more books did Sandy read than Tammy?


Sandy read 4 more books than Tammy read.

## Objective of Topic A

1 Solve compare with difference unknown problem types.

Solve compare with bigger or smaller unknown problem types.

## Focus Area- Topic A

Comparison Word Problems

Tammy read 8 books; Sandy read 4 more books than Tammy. How many books did Sandy read?

Sandy read 12 books.


Sandy read 12 books; Tammy read 4 fewer than Sandy. How many books did Tammy read?

Tammy read 8 books.


Sonny collected 9 baseball cards. Tommy collected 11 baseball cards.
a) How many more baseball cards did Tommy collect than Sonny?

Tommy collected
2 more baseball
cards than Sonny.

b) How many fewer baseball cards did Sonny collect than Tommy?

## Sonny collected 2 fewer baseball cards than Tommy.


c) How many baseball cards did Tommy and Sonny collect?


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11+9=20
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Tommy and Sonny collected 20 baseball cards.
